

We Can't Afford the Afghanistan War

\$ 2 Billion

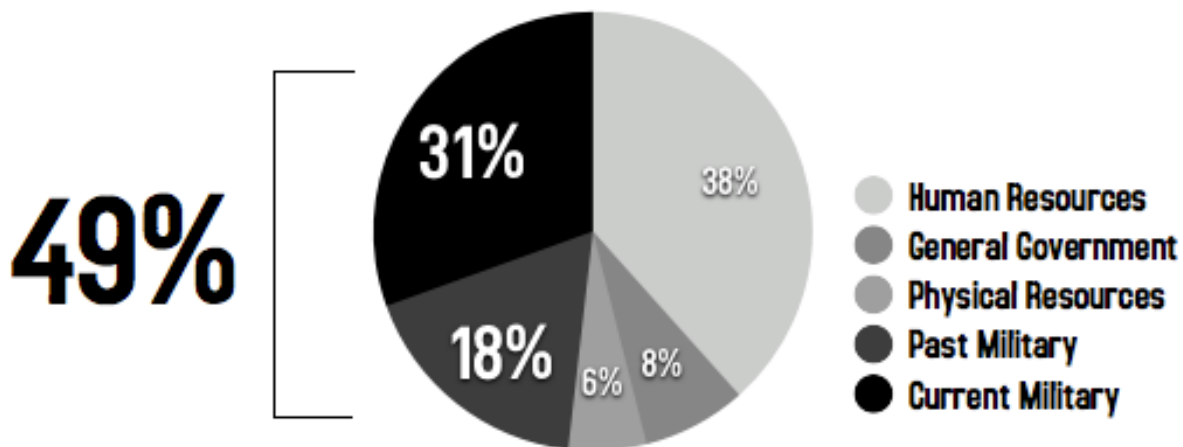
Weekly direct cost of Afghanistan War per week in 2011.

"[Greg] Mortenson says that \$243 million is needed to fund all higher education in Afghanistan this year. He suggests that America hold a press conference here in Kabul and put just 243 of our 100,000 soldiers (each costing \$1 million per year) on planes home. Then the U.S. could take the savings and hand over a check to pay for Afghanistan's universities."
